

Lurleen B. Wallace Office Building



For years the Lurleen B. Wallace Office Building was known simply as “The State Office Building”. It was designed by the prestigious firm of Warren, Knight & Davis of Birmingham to compliment the Public Safety Building it faces and was completed in 1954. Local architects supposedly had the job but were supplanted after a political dustup. It was renamed for Governor Lurleen B Wallace in 1991. The view is taken from the front of the Capitol grounds but looks are

deceiving: you enter on the 4th Floor and exit at the rear on the 1st Floor.
