

Gordon Persons Building

The Gordon Persons Building is a six floor, 672,000 square foot office building. The left half of the structure with the glass bow-front section as the center element was built in the late 1980s on land purchased under the direction of former Governor Forrest Hood “Fob” James and RSA CEO Dr. David Bronner. The building is named in honor of former Governor Gordon Persons.

The Gordon Persons Building includes an underground parking garage as well as a parking lot, and in late 2026 construction will start on a parking deck. The building has undergone several modernization projects, and includes multiple State Agency tenants.
