

# Folsom Administrative Building and Kelly Butler Parking Deck

64 North Union Street, Montgomery, AL 36104



Designed to be part of a matching pair with the former Statehouse and built in 1958 as *The State Administrative Building*, in 1986 it was renamed for former Governor James E. “Big Jim” Folsom. It is also one of six white-painted concrete buildings surrounding the Capitol.

In 2020 the Folsom Data Center and raised Parking Lot was demolished, and a new 203,000 square foot, eight stories cast-in-place concrete parking deck was built. The Kelley Butler Parking Deck is attached to the Folsom Administrative Building and is named in honor of former Alabama Department of Finance Director Kelly Butler.

The Folsom Administrative Building has undergone several modernization projects, and includes the offices of multiple State Agency tenants.
